While working for Barre Engineering & Construction, Inc. in Anaheim California he provided excavation, piping, tank, and pump installation for above & below ground fuel system. He successfully completed projects for numerous clients including: Avis, Hertz, Riverside RTD, San Diego Fire Department, Big Bear Airport, and Orange County Department of Transportation.

In the early 2000's Brian moved west to Colorado where he worked for Envirocon, Inc. in Denver. As a project foreman he oversaw reclamation & environmental remediation efforts including the removal of hazardous waste in the Rocky Flats.

Brian supervised 10 operators and over 30 laborers on the excavation projects of Home Depot & Super Wal-Mart stores in Avon, Colorado as well as the construction of Interstate 70. These jobs required skilled excavating for bridges, streets, buildings, parking lots, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, slopes, retaining walls, and finish grade. From 2003 - 2008 Brian built custom homes in Vail. As the equipment operator he excavated foundations, constructed landscaping ponds, erected retaining walls, dug in septic systems & utility lines, and provided finish grading.

A water enthusiast, Brian began using his excavation skills on rivers in 2006. Since then he has built white water parks and restored rivers throughout Colorado and Wyoming. He finds it exciting to work with water to build recreation parks, restore rivers & streams, and assist the forest service in maintaining public lands.
